The systemic impact on the family will also be briefly addressed including the traumatic impact of sex addiction on partners and children and treating the family using a relational paradigm.

Training Content:	In this interactive session Dr. Carnes will address the basics of recovery from sex addiction for the addict, such as sexual health plans, integrating the 12 steps and common treatment approaches and tools. Treatment for the partner will be addressed including, boundary setting, and tools for navigating the disclosure process including pathways for the partner to heal from the trauma experience. An overview of the couples healing process, including recommendations for disclosure and couples therapy will also be provided.

Dr. Carnes is also a certified sex addiction therapist and supervisor, specializing in therapy for couples and families struggling with sexual addiction. She presents regularly at conferences at both the state and national levels. She is also the author of Facing Heartbreak: Steps to Recovery for Partners of Sex Addicts, and numerous publications on addiction and recovery.
